



During the 40 Days for Life campaign some women scheduled for an abortion at Planned Parenthood see people praying nearby and believe that this is a sign that God wants them to reconsider their abortion. They sometimes approach the sidewalk counselors for help and are referred to 1st Choice for Women or the Great Lakes Gabriel Project.

1st Choice for Women is a nearby pregnancy center operated by the Great Lakes Gabriel Project. 1st Choice services are FREE and include pregnancy tests, peer-counseling, ultrasounds and information about abortion and its alternatives.

The Great Lakes Gabriel Project is a network of churches trained and ready to provide relationship, material resources and emotional and spiritual support during pregnancy and after the baby is born.



## Since the first 40 Days for Life campaign in 2007:

**600,000** people in over 500 cities have joined to pray and fast for an end to abortion.

**16,500** churches have participated in 40 Days for Life campaigns.

 $8,\!245$  lives have been reported as spared from abortion – and those are just the ones we

know about.

**88** abortion workers have quit their jobs and walked away from the abortion industry.

**44** abortion facilities have completely shut down following local 40 Days for Life campaigns.
